# **First Business Meeting**

### I. Call to Order

Speaker of the House Beth Weber called the 34th Annual Meeting of the ASRT House of Delegates to order at 8:21 a.m., Friday, June 21, 2019.

# V. Credentials Report

Vice Speaker of the House Joseph Whitton presented the Credentials Report. Out of a possible 168 delegates, 156 were credentialed as follows:

Credentialed Chapter Delegates: 58
Total Credentialed Delegates: 156
